I hope you and your bees are surviving the winter. We had a longer than normal stretch of cold weather in Nov. and Dec. I checked hives last week on a warm day and found several with the bees up in the top box, this leaves them no place to go over the next few weeks to get honey. When it is below 57° F the cluster can only move up. So, the first warm day you get, check your hives and move frames of honey above the cluster if needed.
